

## Replication

The Replicator Cart allows BluePrint users to copy aspects of a course gradually. You can add content and/or structural components to this cart and replicate them within the existing course or across courses. In short, this feature makes it easy to create new courses from existing ones. We recommend using the replicator cart when creating multiple courses that should include the same or similar content to help save you time and work more efficiently.



#### You can clone:

- Lessons
- Flashcards
- Questions
- Tests
- Passages
- Categories (Lesson, Flashcard, Question)
- Study Tasks
- Study Task Groups
- Full Courses

# **Clearing the Replicator Cart**

Before replicating content, it's important to make sure the replicator cart is empty. This way, you do not replicate/clone any additional content by accident. To clear the cart:

- 1. Log into BluePrint
- 2. Click Courses
- 3. Click the Name of the Desired Course you wish to replicate content from
- 4. Click Replicator Cart on the Left Navigation Menu
- 5. Review what's in your cart and click Clear Cart on the upper right to proceed



Once the cart is clear, you are ready to begin the replication process.





- In your existing course, click the content section you wish to replicate on the left.
   This could be Flashcards, Lessons, etc.
- 2. **Check the box(es)** next to the content you want to replicate **on the left**.
- Click Replicate at the top, middle of your screen.
- The Replicator Cart will open with options that you can choose from. Note: The options for replication will be different based on what content you choose to replicate.

**Example**: If you connected questions to this new lesson, you'll want to bring over those connections. You can also bring over any study tasks and groups you built with your new content.

- Once you have finished selecting your replication options, click Add to Cart on the lower right.
- Navigate back to the left menu options and click Replicator Cart
- 7. The content you selected should be in the list.
- 8. If the content is what you're trying to add to new courses, click **Replicate**.
- 9. On the next screen you will be asked to select a destination for your replicated course content.


  Use the dropdown box to select the appropriate course.
- 10. Once finished, click Replicate.
- 11. Clear the Replicator Cart

### Replicating a Complete Course

Before you run a full course replication, make sure that your course is built. This ensures that you will clone your course with all your most recent changes made in BluePrint.


Additionally, if you have custom styling, replicating will also replicate all custom content styling, for your convenience.

To Replicate a Complete Course:





- In BluePrint, click the name of the course you would like to replicate.
- Click the Replicate Course button on the top right-hand side of the screen
- This will open the Full Course Replication window.
- 4. Select your **desired course replication** options. These
  options include whether or
  not the new course should
  keep a relationship to the



- original course and what course data should be cloned.

  5. Scroll to the bottom of the window and press **Replicate.**
- 6. You will receive an email with the new Course ID when it's completed.

## Replicator Log

Similar to the Activity Log, the Replicator Log allows you to view all the replicate activity by Source Content (e.g., Questions, Lessons, Exams, etc.). You can also use filters to further drill down results.
