PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THE VERSATONE. DO NOT THROW AWAY THESE INSTRUCTIONS.

- 1. This product is not intended for medical use.
- 2. Consult your physician before using this product if:
 - a. You are pregnant.
 - b. You have been fitted with a pacemaker, an implant, or other medical aid.
 - c. You suffer from diabetes.
 - d. You have a circulatory disorder.
 - e. You have any concerns about your health.

- 3. Older or infirm persons should consult their doctor before using the product, even if they have no specific preexisting conditions.
- 4. Stop using immediately if you feel discomfort or pain.
- 5. Do not use this product immediately before going to bed. The appliance has a stimulating effect and can delay sleep.
- 6. If you suspect a problem, stop using the device immediately.
- 7. Store the device in its packaging for prolonged storage or in a secure, dry and cool place.
- 8. Do not place any other objects on the device.
- 9. To avoid the risk of damage to device, keep away from moisture. Do not use if the device is wet or damp.

Children should not play with the device. Cleaning and user maintenance must not be performed by children unless they are over 13 years old and supervised. - 1. Do not use this device after heating or cooling to avoid deformation of the device.
- 2. Avoid moving this device between sharp temperature changes if-possible.
- This device is not waterproof. Use this device in a dry location. Do not submerge this device in water. Avoid using this device in areas with high humidity such as bathrooms.
- 4. Clean the area of use on your body prior to using this device.

Before Each Use

- We recommend charging the Versatone before each use.
- Before applying the Versatone belt to the skin, make sure to clean the silicone pad.
- Do not use lotions or oils before putting on the Versatone belt.
- Removing the Versatone belt will power off the motor when not in contact with skin.
 Make sure the Versatone belt is properly powered off before adjusting for abdominal or back treatment.

How Does It Work?

What does EMS (electronic muscle stimulation) do?

EMS stimulates healthy muscles in order to improve and facilitate muscle performance. Use for the improvement of muscle tone, firmness, and strength.

What does TENS (transcutaneous electrical nerve stimulation) do?

TENS provides soothing, temporary pain relief associated with sore and aching muscles due to strain from exercise or normal household and work activities. It is also intended for symptomatic relief and management of chronic, intractable pain.

The Versatone has 4 EMS modes and 2 TENS modes.

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USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1



Mount Control Module onto the Versatone EMS belt.

STEP 2



Lightly mist water onto the silicone pad.

STEP 3



Press "+" to turn ON and start.
Press "+" to increase electric pulse intensity.
The default intensity setting is 0.

STEP 4



Press "M" to cycle through modes.

Modes can be changed during workouts.

Intensity level resets to 0 after mode change.

STEP 5



Press "-" to decrease electric pulse intensity. Press and hold "-" to turn OFF.

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CARE & MAINTENANCE

After Each Use

Remove the Versatone and clean thoroughly with a soft cloth. Pat dry and store in a cool, dry, and clean place.

Cleaning

Always turn the Versatone control unit OFF before cleaning.

- Cleaning while powered ON may cause minor electric stimulus.
- Do not rub the electrodes with excessive force. This may damage the electrodes.
- · Do not rinse with water.
- Do not clean the control unit with paint thinner, benzine, or alcohol.
- · Make sure your hands are clean when handling the silicone pad.
- · Do not apply water on the control unit.

Instructions:

- Gently wipe off any sweat or moisture from the silicone pad with a soft cloth to avoid scratching the surface.
- If dirty, wet a soft cloth with diluted detergent (5% detergent to 95% lukewarm water). Wring out excess water from the cloth and gently wipe off dirt.
- Rinse the cloth with water, wring out excess water, and wipe off remaining detergent.
- Let the product air-dry in a well-ventilated place out of direct sunlight.

Charging

Plug the USB cable into a USB-compatible wall charger.

- When plugged in and charging the indicator lights will be flashing blue. The indicator lights work as battery level indication.
- When fully charged all 3 blue indicator lights will appear solid.

FAO

Q: Can I use this product every day?

A: Yes, the Versatone can be used every day. However, we suggest one workout course per day per body part. Do not use the Versatone on a single area of the body repeatedly to avoid muscle fatigue. If you feel discomfort or experience skin abnormalities, stop using the Versatone immediately and consult your doctor.

Q: Can I use the Versatone in a sauna?

A: The Versatone is not waterproof. Do not use it in areas of high humidity such as saunas or bathrooms to avoid injury, product damage, or dirt built-up.

Q: How do I properly maintain the Versatone?

A: Wipe dirt from the Versatone surface with a dry cloth. Refer to page 8 for more cleaning instructions.

Q: Which electric pulse intensity should I use?

A: Set a low intensity level to start. Once you have adapted to the lower intensity levels, you can try turning the intensity up higher.

Q: Which parts of the body can the Versatone be used with?

A: Do not use the Versatone on body parts above the neck, such as the head, face, or spine. Areas around the chest and shoulder blade should also be avoided.

Q: Can I use the Versatone if I have a heart condition?

A: Those who have heart conditions should not use the Versatone. For more details, see the Safety Notices starting on page 3.

Q: Why did the Versatone suddenly power off during my workout?

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A: The battery is depleted and needs charged.

Q: Can women who are pregnant use the Versatone.

A: Women who are pregnant should not use the Versatone. Women who are in postpartum should consult their doctor before using the Versatone.

FAQ

Q: Can I use the Versatone while I am asleep?

A: Do not use the Versatone while you are asleep.

Q: Will I experience muscle pain when I use this product?

A: Similar to other exercises, you may experience muscle pain when you use the Versatone. Discontinue use or lower the workout intensity level if you experience any pain or discomfort.

Q: Why do I feel that the workout intensity of the Versatone is lower than previous uses?

A: If you feel that the workout intensity of the Versatone is lower than previous uses or you cannot feel the electric pulses after several workouts, charge the battery.

Q: Why do I feel that the electric pulses are weaker over time than the first use?

A: After using the Versatone over time you will adapt to the electric pulse intensity. This may make you feel that the workout intensity is not as high as before. As you adapt to your current intensity settings, increase gradually.
