




Key Changes Procurement Purchase Requisition APP

- Oracle updated the purchase requisition APP project name Redwood also known as the RSSP.
 - This change is mandatory for all Oracle customers.
- Purchase Requisition APP is a layout and format change only.
- Shopping, requisition forms and catalogs remain the same.
- Creating, Editing, Approval step remain unchanged some differences in requisition and PO status naming.
- Business unit and location are now prominently displayed.
- My Requisition Search uses AI to provide tailored searching.
 - Quotes around a key word e.g. "damage" will only bring in the results that meet that criteria.
 - Saved searches in RSSP are longer available but you can see your past search filters.
 - Search function in RSSP does takes practice.
 - Search in classic has mandatory fields RSSP does not use mandatory fields so there is more flexibility.













Purchase Requisition APP home screen classic vs RSSP




Updating business unit (BU) and location address classic vs RSSP












Manage Requisition (classic) vs My Requisition (RSSP)



Within classic view there is no access to view PO lines, In RSSP you choose to view by Requisition or by Lines. RSSP allows direct access to edit the line using the ellipses ...




Manage Requisition (classic) vs My Requisition (RSSP)

RSSP Terminology change: REQ Incomplete is now Draft. PO status is now available such as Delivered, Billed or Order canceled.










Shop by category, browse all catalogs view classic vs RSSP



Classic view lists subcategories, brand and price and there is a view button update the columns. In RSSP category list and to adjust view, select the double box, use check boxes to add remove view, and slide the double lines to reorder the columns. **NOTE:** When looking at catalogs, use the list view to ease of use.

Key Terms

We will use the following key terms throughout the course:

Key Term	Description
Business Units	Application organization that performs business functions, partition process steps, secures process steps and shares reference data. Examples of BU are Hertz US RAC or Hertz FR RAC.
Holds	Holds are constraints that payables automatically apply to an invoice or a Supplier, or that can be manually placed on an invoice, to prevent payment and, in some cases creation of accounting entries.
Invoice	An itemized bill from a supplier representing an amount due for goods supplied or services rendered.
Inventory	Products or items held in specific locations to meet future demand. Inventory is classified as an asset on a company's balance sheet.
Local Catalog	A catalog is used for item offerings from supplier that may have fixed prices or a fixed description and PO category.
Punchout Catalog	A catalog can either be a direct link to an Oracle Exchange marketplace or a supplier's web store, where the requisitioner shops for items and finally returns to Oracle Self Service Procurement to create the requisition with the items selected in the marketplace or supplier's web store.
Purchase Order	A commercial document issued by a buyer to a seller indicating types, quantities and agreed prices for products or services.
Receiving	A process to provide the electronic confirmation that you have physically received goods or services.



Key Terms (Cont.)

We will use the following key terms throughout the course:

Key Term	Description
Requisition	A Purchase Requisition (REQ) is created as an intent to procure goods and services form a vendor. Once the REQ is reviewed and approved, then it will be converted to a Purchase Order (PO).
Services	A process step in which no physical goods are transferred from the seller to the buyer. Services are represented by various categories (For example- telecommunications, sub-recipient)
Smart Forms	A Smart Form can be used as a template to guide requisitioners during Purchase Requisition creation.
