

Screening Labs

Purpose	Record and manage hepatitis, sexually transmitted infection, and other screening lab results in CAREWare 6.
Who should do this	CAREWare staff who enter or review clinical screening lab data.
Use this guide when you need to	You need to add a screening lab result to a client record or review available screening lab options.
Main warning	Confirm the test date, lab name, and result before you save the record.

Quick path: Client record > Screening Labs > Add > enter the test date, lab name, and result > Save

Standard and Custom Screening Labs

CAREWare includes these common screening labs:

- Chlamydia
- Cytomegalovirus (CMV)
- Epstein-Barr virus (EBV)
- Genital herpes
- Gonorrhea
- Hepatitis A, B, and C screening labs
- Human papillomavirus (genital warts)
- Interferon-gamma release assay (IGRA)
- Measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR)
- Non-specific urethritis
- Syphilis
- Toxoplasma IgG antibody
- Varicella (chicken pox)

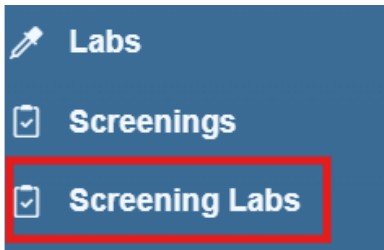
RSR Reporting Requirement

Required field: Date and Screening Lab Name = Q.55 Client was screened for syphilis during this reporting period.

How to Add Screening Labs to a Client Record

Step 1. Select Screening Labs in the left menu of the client record.

Screening Labs Menu Options

Button	What it does
View	View details for an existing screening lab record.
Add	Add a screening lab record.
Delete	Delete an existing screening lab record.
HL7 Source	View the HL7 holding tank record for a screening lab entry.
Print or Export	Print or export the list of screening lab records.
Column Visibility	Choose which columns appear in the screening lab list.

Tip: Select Save and Add when you need to enter more than one screening lab in the client record.

How to Confirm It Worked

- The saved screening lab appears in the Screening Labs list for the client.
- The test date, lab name, and result match the information you entered.

Troubleshooting and Common Questions

How do I find a lab in a long list?

Type the first letters of the lab name to shorten the list. You can also use the page controls to move through all results.

How do I enter several screening labs?

Select Save and Add after each entry until you have entered all screening labs.

Where do I add a custom lab?

Add provider-specific and custom labs in Screening Lab Setup under [Clinical Setup](#).
