1 SELECT CORE SUBJECTS

A full-time load of 7th grade courses includes:

- Religion & Bible History¹
- English
- Literature
- History²
- Mathematics
- Science

¹Religion includes the Bible History course.

²Select Light to the Nations 1 or Challenge of Freedom.

2 SELECT ADDITIONAL COURSES

Other courses parents may wish to add:

- Vocabulary
- Classical Composition¹
- Foreign Language²

¹Begin with Fable stage or student's current stage. Complete Classical Composition in lieu of the Composition portion of Kolbe's English course.

²Kolbe offers Latin, Greek, Spanish, and French.
