RISING SENIOR

- Register for second SAT, ACT, and/or CLT.
- · Open a Parchment account for the student using the student's personal email address.
- Narrow college list.

JULY-AUG

- · Submit second semester, junior year, parentreported grades and sample coursework in the Kolbe Portal.
- Visit colleges.
- Create Common Application account. Choose Kolbe as your school & your advisor as your school counselor for the form.
- Contact recommenders, if you haven't already.

SENIOR FALL SEMESTER

- Remember Early Action & Early Decision deadlines.
- AUG-OCT
- · Begin researching scholarships.
- · Visit colleges.
- Possibly take SAT, ACT, and/or CLT again.
- Register for AP Exams locally.

SENIOR LATE FALL

- Submit final applications.
- Request mid-year reports.
- Turn in scholarship applications.

NOV-JAN

- Review financial aid offers.
- Track acceptances & financial aid.
- FAFSA Application Opens Dec. 1.

SENIOR EARLY SPRING

· Complete & submit applications for Regular

JAN-MAR

- Apply for scholarships.
- Submit first semester, parent-reported grades and sample coursework in the Kolbe Portal.

SENIOR LATE SPRING

College decision & deposit. Inform other schools of decision as a courtesy.

APR-JUN

- Important! After reporting all coursework, submit your Kolbe graduation application. This finalizes your transcript by adding the graduation date.
- Submit final transcript to college via Parchment.
