1 SELECT CORE SUBJECTS

A full-time load of 4th grade courses includes:

- Religion
- English
- Vocabulary
- Reading or Literature
- History
- Mathematics¹
- Science

2 SELECT ADDITIONAL COURSES

Other courses parents may wish to add:

- Classical Comp.¹
- Phonics
- Geography
- Latin²

¹Begin with Fable stage or student's current stage. Complete Classical Comp. in lieu of the Composition portion of Kolbe's English course.

²Select Intro to Latin, Elementary Latin, or First Form.
