SELECT CORE SUBJECTS

A full-time load of 8th grade courses includes:

- Religion/ Bible History¹
- English
- Literature
- History
- Mathematics²
- Science³

¹Religion includes the Bible History course.

²Select a middle or high school level math, taking note of pre-requisites.

³Select a topic not learned yet or a high school level science, noting co-requisites.

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SELECT ADDITIONAL COURSES

Other courses parents may wish to add:

- Vocabulary
- Classical Comp.¹
- Foreign Language²

¹Begin with Fable stage or student's current stage. Complete Classical Compo. in lieu of the Composition portion of Kolbe's English course.

²Kolbe offers Latin, Greek, Spanish, and French.
