

Instruction for updating driver files on Mac.

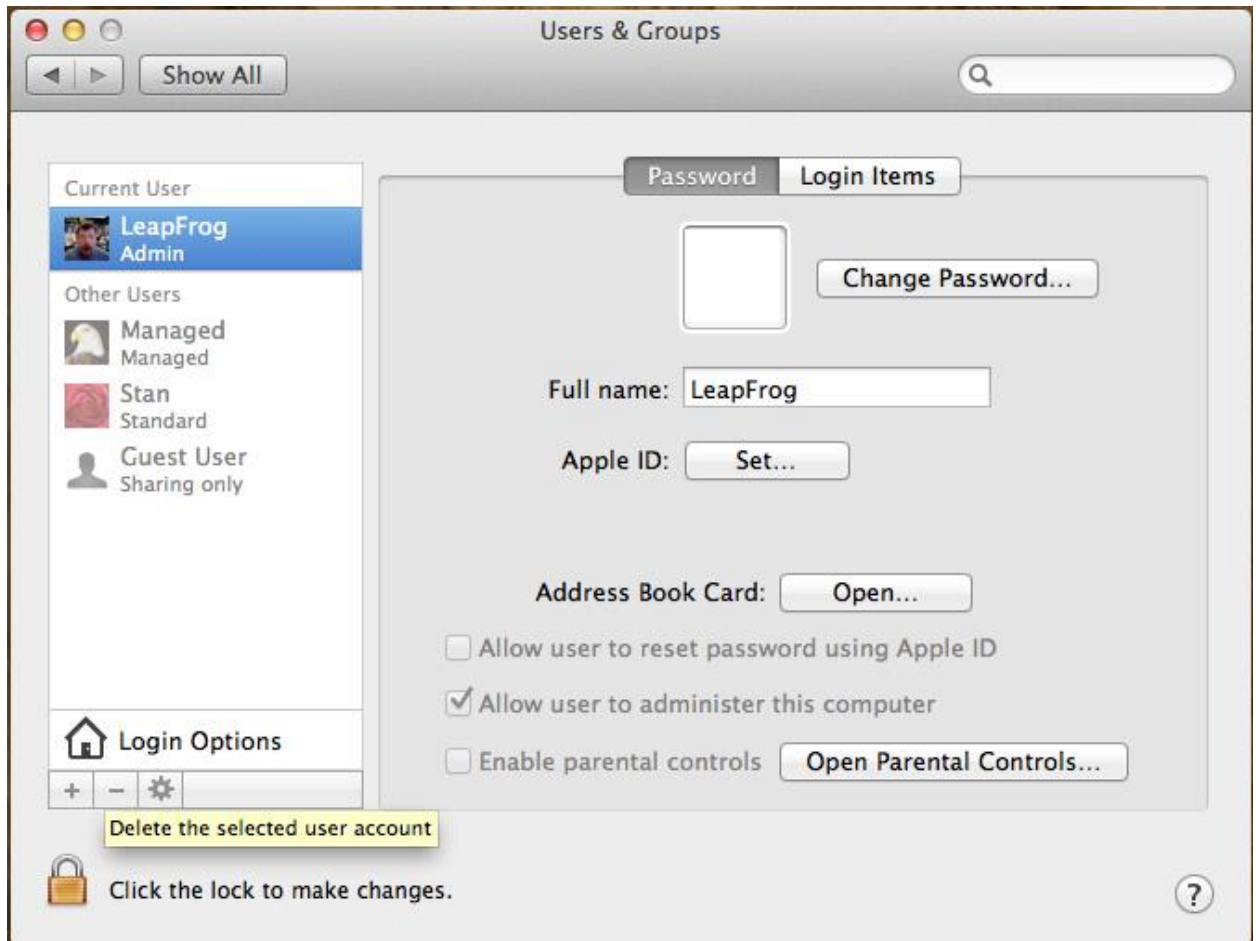
Admin Password. In order to use this fix, you need to have a Password set for the Admin user, if you have a password already please skip this section and proceed to the next step labeled: Updating the Driver

To set an Admin Password:

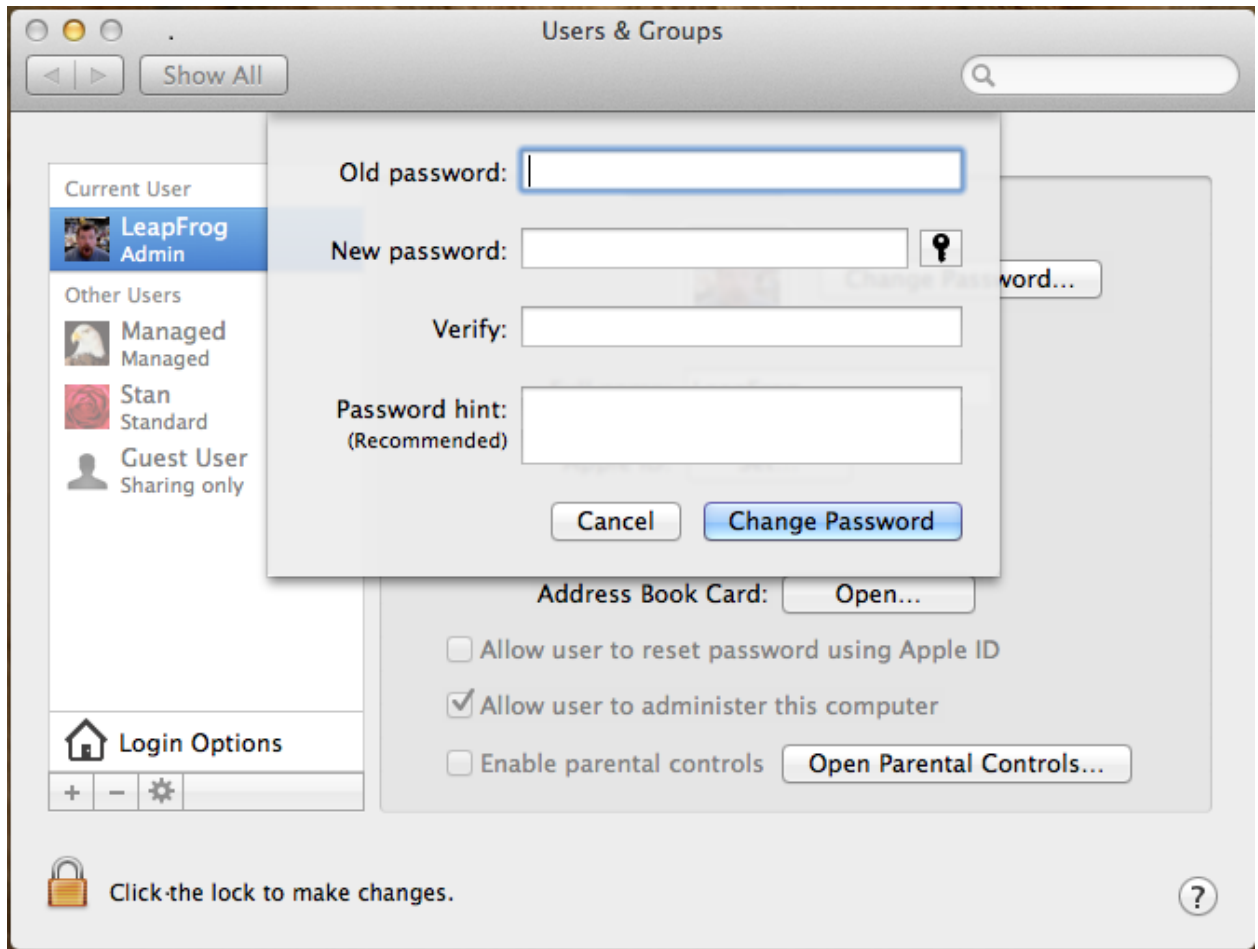
- 1) Open the System preferences located in the applications folder



2) Open Users and Groups, select the Admin User and click on Change Password



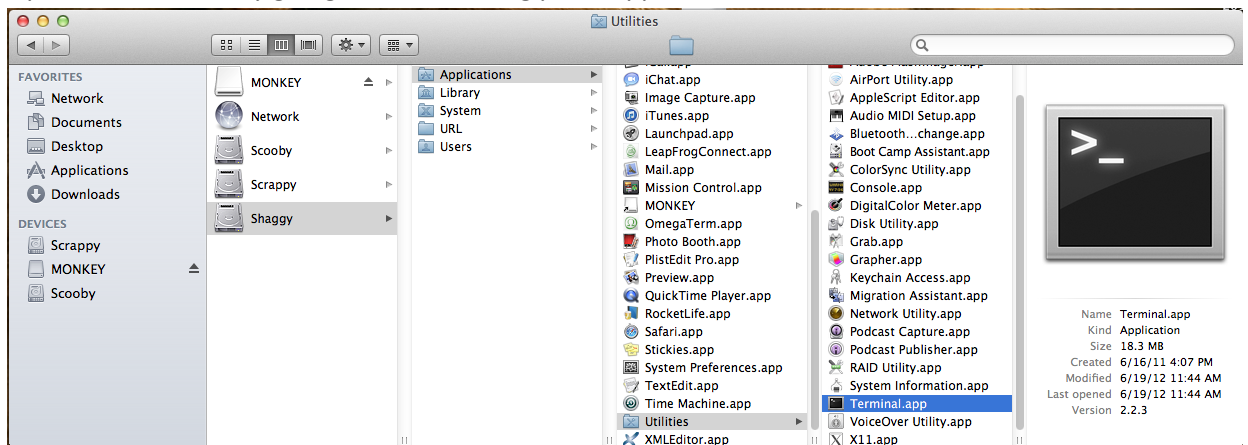
- 3) Enter new password, re-enter password and click Change Password



- 4) That's it, you have set an Admin Password.

Updating the Driver:

- 1) Open the Terminal by going to the following path: Applications/Utilities/Terminal



- 2) With the Terminal open input the following: `sudo touch /System/Library/Extensions`  
(On 10.10 Yosemite only this will be: `sudo touch /Library/Extensions`)

- 3) You will be prompted for your password, enter it and hit return
- 4) Wait about 2 minutes then re-launch the LFC application and connect the device again.
