
Joining a Blackboard Collaborate Session


- 1. Use Edge or Google Chrome browser

> next, click Blackboard Collaborate Ultra.







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
3. Allow your browser to use your microphone and camera

- 5. Open the **Collaborate panel** in the bottom right corner of the screen for more options.




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6. Open the Session menu in the top left corner of the screen to leave the session





Tips and Troubleshooting

- Use a headset with an attached microphone. A headset is ideal for cutting down on feedback and background noises.
- Are you using Edge or Chrome browser?
- Joining the session early will give you time to get to know your way around and troubleshoot any audio or video problems.
- Muting your microphone when you're not speaking will cut down on audio feedback and distracting background noises.
- Keep the other applications you are running to a minimum.
